Dear Parents,

Federal law (NCLB) requires that we share with you the qualifications of teachers in our schools. You have the right to request and review information from your school on the professional qualifications of your child's teachers. There are questions you may ask, including:

- Is my child's teacher licensed to teach the grades or subjects assigned?
- Has the state waived any requirements for my child's teacher?
- What was the college major of my child's teacher?
- What degrees does my child's teacher hold?
- Are there instructional aides working with my child? If so, what are their qualifications?

As we begin the 2008-2009 school year, all teachers at Mt. Zion High School are highly qualified and licensed to teach their assigned subject areas.
